- Due to their attachment, they will see faults as being qualities.

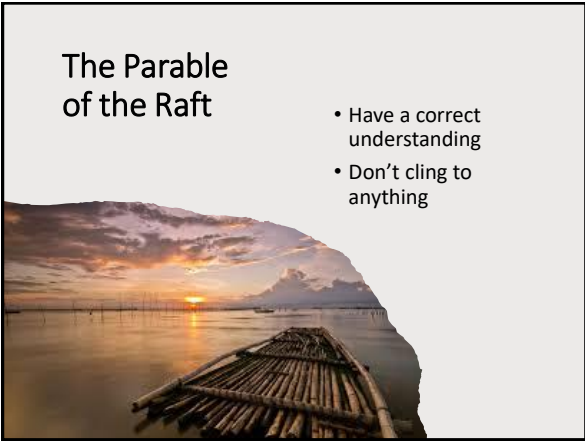
