- 1. Expound on four of the advantages of properly relying on a spiritual teacher and four disadvantages of improper reliance.
- 2. Discuss the qualities required from the side of the student to have a beneficial student teacher relationship.
- 3. Explain the practice of developing proper reliance on the spiritual teacher through thought and action.
- 4. What benefit do we receive from thinking about the kindness of the spiritual teacher?
- 5. Describe your understanding of how one goes about looking for and evaluating a prospective spiritual teacher.
- 6. Explain how to work with a crisis in your relationship with your spiritual mentor.

- 1. <u>Need for a teacher.</u> Why does one need a spiritual teacher?
- 2. Finding a teacher. How does one find a teacher?
- 3. <u>Different levels of teachers.</u> What are the different levels of a spiritual teacher and how does one relate to the different levels? (Levels: individual liberation, Mahayana teachers, tantric teachers. Relate to teachers respectively as: representatives of the Buddha, like a Buddha, a Buddha)
- 4. Why does one need different types of spiritual teachers at different levels of spiritual practice?
- 5. <u>Qualifications of a teacher.</u> What are the qualifications of a Mahayana teacher? (ten from *Liberation in the Palm of Your Hand*)
- 6. Qualifications of a disciple. What are the qualifications of a Mahayana disciple? (intelligent, open-minded, willing to make effort)
- 7. <u>Dealing with difficulties.</u> What does one do when one encounters problems in a spiritual teacher & disciple relationship? What are some techniques that can be applied to restore the relationship?
- 8. What does one do if it just is not working despite the techniques?
- 9. <u>Importance of checking up.</u> Discuss the importance of examining the qualities of a potential spiritual teacher.
- 10. <u>Respecting teachers.</u> How should we view teachers of other traditions or teachers who teach something we do not understand or believe to be true?
