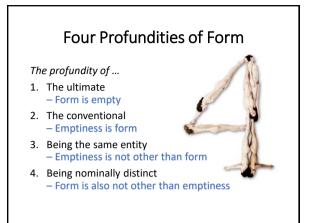
Form is empty. Emptiness is form. Emptiness is not other than form; form is also not other than emptiness.

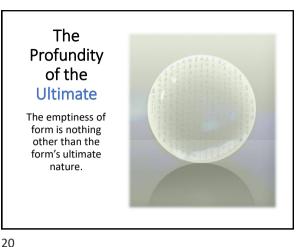
